WHAT IS A RECOVERY RESIDENCE?

A certified recovery home will be a safe home-like alcohol free and illicit drug free environment which supports a person's own recovery goals using the social model of recovery. Structured living allows relationships to develop with other positive people in recovery who want to help each other stay sober. Recovery residences rely on recovery support services such as 12-step meetings, outpatient clinical services such as peer support, and other community connections to help their residents reintegrate into society and gain meaningful employment.

NARR provides a national unified voice for the Recovery Residence field. WVARR is the recognized state affiliate in West Virginia. NARR provides resources for their certified operators and engages them in a national monthly call--as well as encouraging mentorship relationships between operators.
